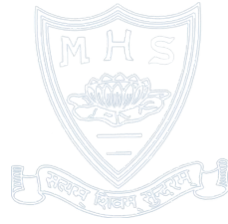

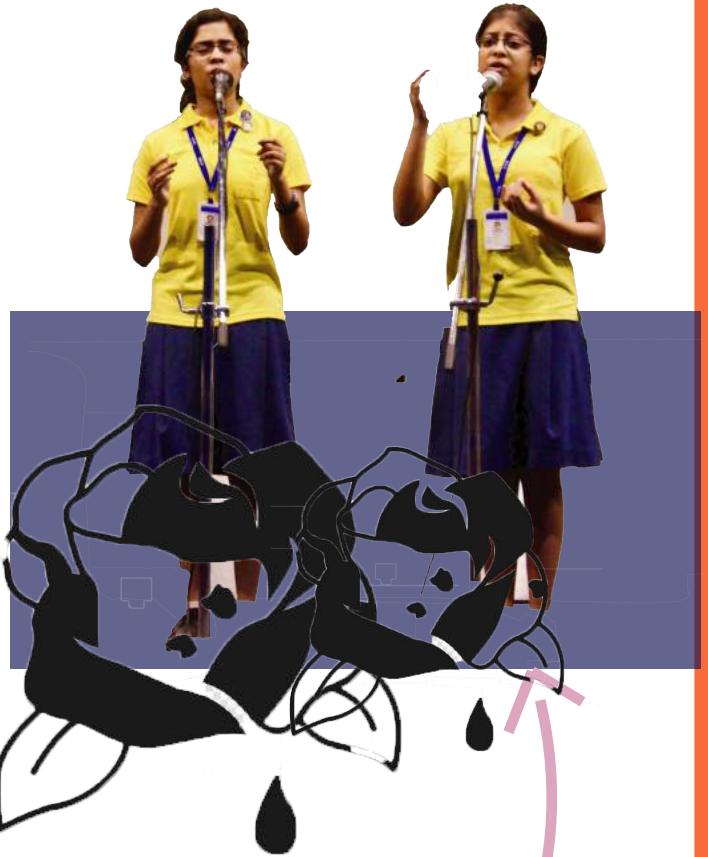

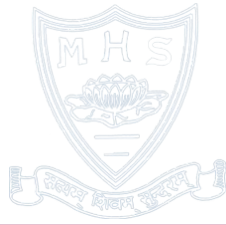
# WHY MAITREE?

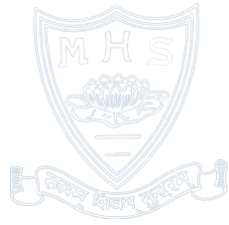
# WAR OF WORDS

Was the motion for today's debate.

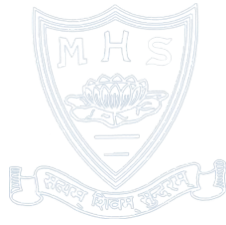

## **HIBISCUS HOUSE'S INSTALLATION**

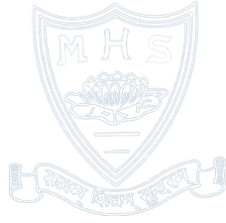

Hibiscus House, not revealing their theme left us in an air of curiosity by keeping their theme from us. Nonetheless we captured the mesmerizing face of their sculpture

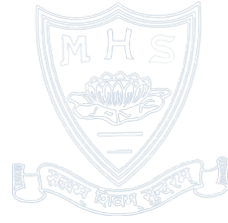


# MAKE YOUR BLUES GO AWAY

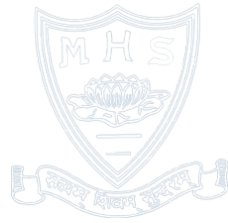

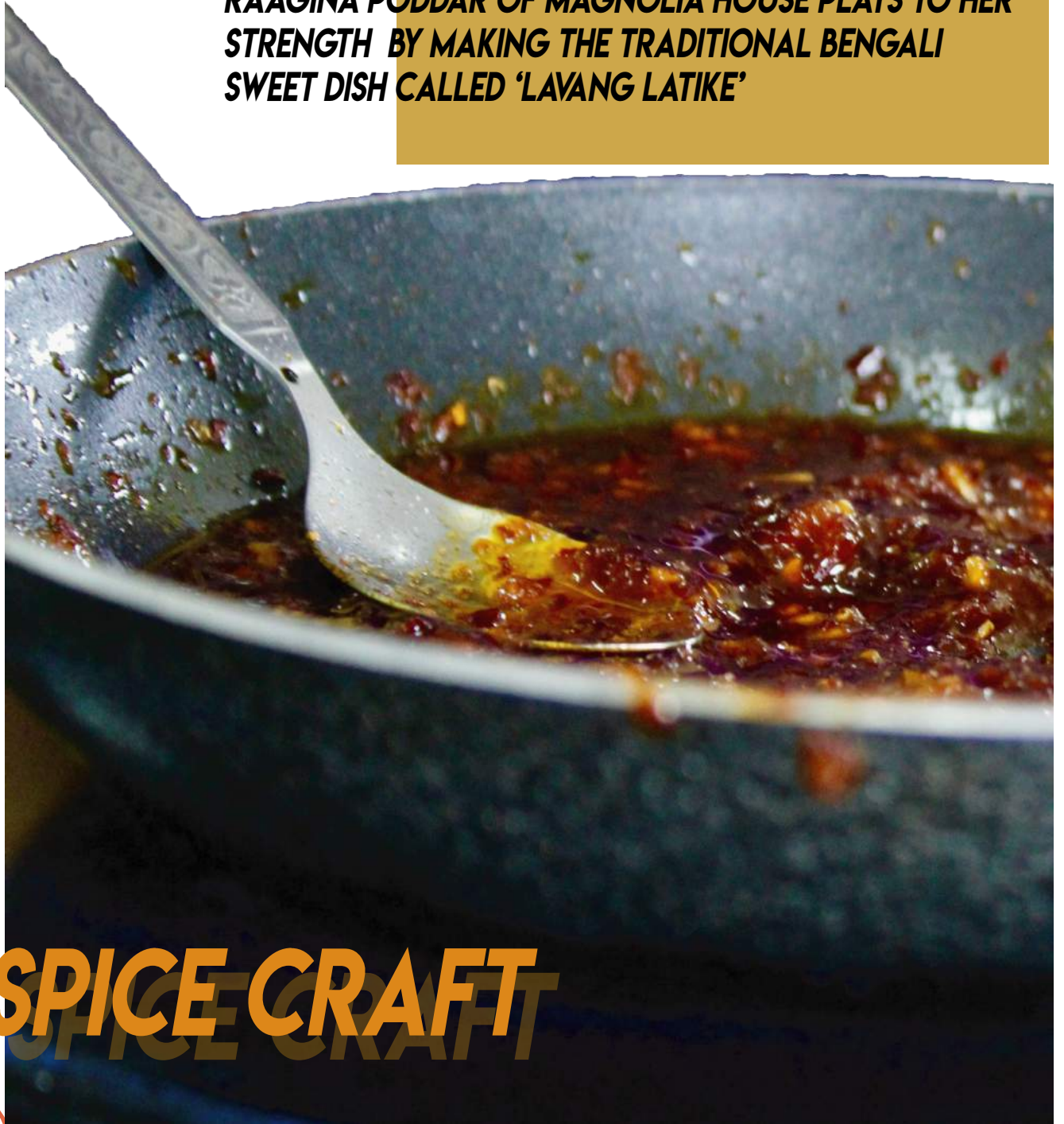

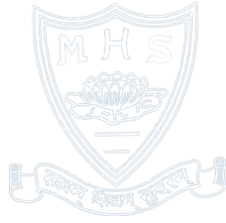
