DIALOGUE 1: Humanities Through the Lens of Empathy

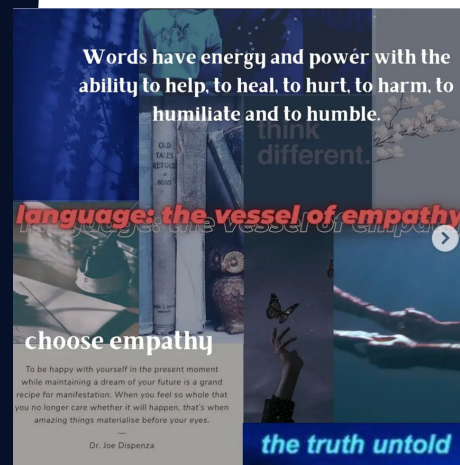
The first dialogue presented a unique take on the cost of sustainability in the midst of a growing geometric population when food production grows only arithmetically.
