





Das Proletariat (working class) people who don't own big business factory and earn their living by selling the labour work to others.


die Gerechtigkeit

Die Gleichheit




3. Die Gleichheit (Equality)
The right of all group of people to have a similar social position and receive the same treatment. Equality means no one is richer or more powerful just because they run a company.

4. Die Ungleichheit (Inequality) the unfair situation in society where people have more have more opportunities and resources than others.

4. Die Klasse (a group of people within the society who have some economic social position) divided based on how much money, job, what they own, business, etc.

5. Die Bourgeoisie (means owners) people who own business, land, factories, and make money from the work done by others.
