**ADMISSIONS POLICY**

Modern High School for Girls offers classes from Pre-Primary to Higher Secondary. The division of levels are as follows:

Junior	Senior
Pre-Primary: Nursery, LKG & UKG	Middle School: Classes 6 to 8
Primary: Classes 1 & 2	Secondary School: Classes 9 & 10
Upper Primary: Classes 3 to 5	Higher Secondary School: Classes 11 & 12

**Admission Policy for Senior School**

Modern High School for Girls follows a fair, transparent and merit-based admission process for all applicants. The School does not entertain recommendations and any application found to be supported by recommendation or undue influence will be subject to disqualification.

All applications for admission are processed through the dedicated admissions portal available on the School website. Parents and guardians are expected to complete the application process online and provide all required information and documentation within the stipulated timelines.

Admissions are granted only against available vacancies. While vacancies may arise at any level, the School's principal intake points are Nursery and Class 11. A larger number of seats are generally available at the Higher Secondary level and admissions to Class 11 are conducted during a designated admission cycle with assessments scheduled at specific times. In the event that vacancies arise later in the academic year, applications may be considered subject to availability and the School's admission criteria.

For admission to the Middle School, Secondary School and Higher Secondary School levels, applicants are assessed on the basis of their previous school reports, performance in written assessments and personal interviews. The School reserves the right to determine the suitability of a candidate through one or more of these evaluation methods.

The School is committed to supporting students and families in making informed academic choices. Therefore, detailed discussions and counselling regarding subject selection are conducted at the end of Class 8 and Class 10 to facilitate a smooth transition into the Secondary and Higher Secondary stages respectively.
